Mathru Abhaya Foundation is a registered society(NGO) based in Hyderabad, registered under the A.P. Societies registrations act 2001, Registered 12(A) & 80G of the Income tax act, 1961.

The foundation is not only catering the needs of orphans but also to the needy children. Mathru Abhaya foundation is established to help provide orphan children with accommodation, education, knowledge under one roof. It is dedicated to provide various facilities and impart training to fulfill the aims and objectives to make the Orphan children independent and respectable citizens in the society.

Mathru Abhaya Foundation was Initiated by Ramatenki Ramesh along with his friends, educationists and philosophers. R. Ramesh (Founder) studied till U.G and Post Graduation from Osmania University by taking shelter at one of the orphanage homes in Hyderabad. When he was in Degree(B.Sc), Ramesh had a thought of it by establishing a home, he could help the students who were in desperate need and orphans. That's how our orphan home started.

This is to bring to your notice that currently Mathru abhaya foundation is running under the supervision of Mr. R Ramesh(Boys Home) and Mrs. R Devakadevi (Girls Home).

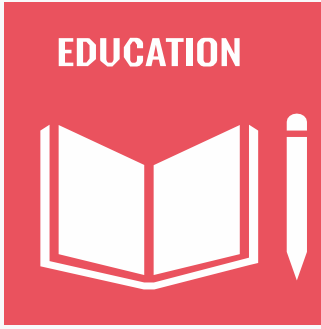

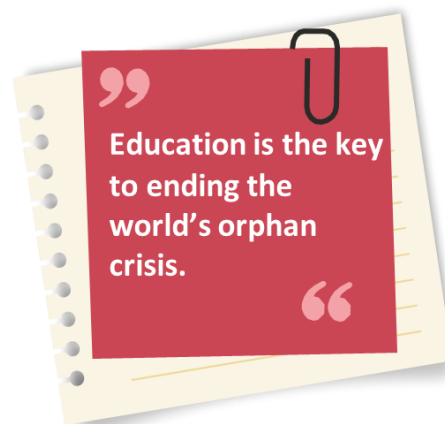
1. Children who have lost both or single parent

HEALTH CARE FOR ORPHAN CHILDREN

For Ordinary ailments and emergency medical help, we admit the children into the near by hospitals and the consultation is nominal. Prescribed medicines are bought from the nearby medical shop. We generally maintain a first-aid kit for emergency and stock of medicines it includes

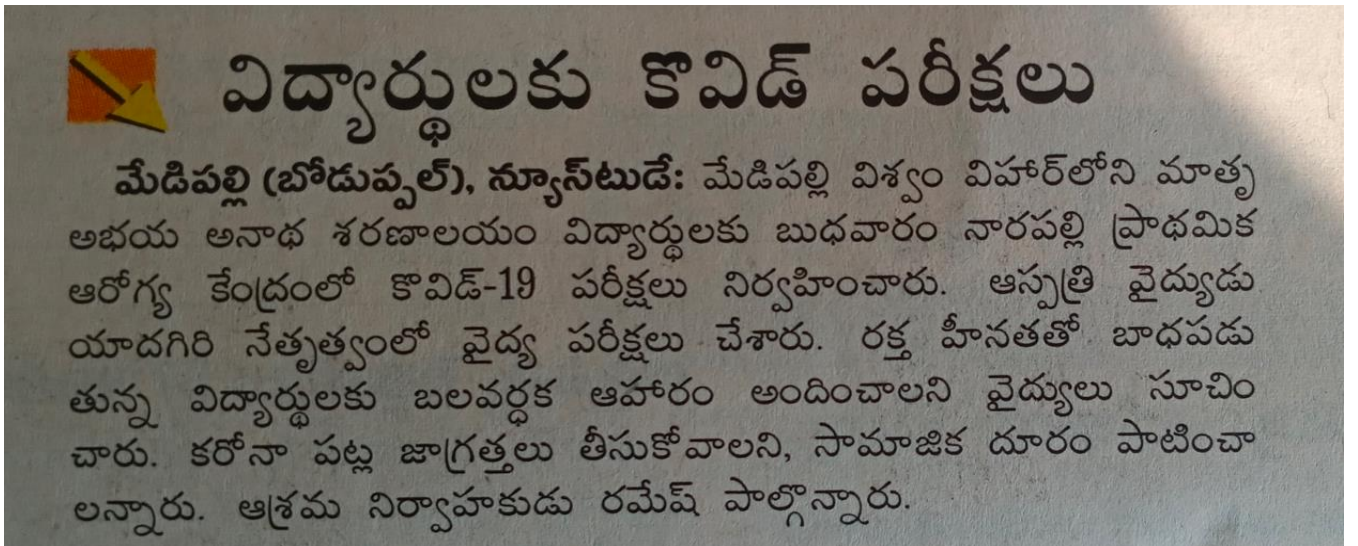

We have periodic check ups from private hospitals and doctors in their individual capacity. Especially We would like to thank Prajwala clinic staff and AB New Life staff for treating our children in emergency situations for both boys and girls. We are indebted to their service through out our entire life's.





SHELTER



We are having both different rented homes separately for boys and girls. The rented house consists of 2 bed rooms, study room, sick room, counselling room and playing area. Few rooms have iron racks for keeping clothes and shelves for books, school bags and other necessary things. Study room consists of study chairs for all the children to study and finish their homework.

Playing area is generally used for tuition classes as well as dining hall. Water purifier is installed for drinking water in the premises.

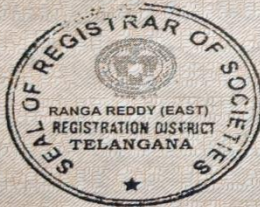
