The foundation was established with the aim of providing orphaned children with accommodation, education, and knowledge, all under one roof. It is dedicated to providing various facilities and training programs to fulfill its objectives of making orphaned children independent and respected members of society.

Mathru Abhaya Foundation was initiated by Ramatenki Ramesh, along with a group of friends, educationists, and philosophers. Ramesh, the founder of the foundation, pursued his undergraduate and postgraduate studies at Osmania University while residing at an orphanage home in Hyderabad. During his Bachelor's degree studies, Ramesh had a vision of establishing a home to assist students in dire need and orphaned children. This led to the establishment of Mathru Abhaya Foundation.



- 3. Children of disabled parents who are unable to care for them.
- 4. Child laborers who have been rescued and require a safe and nurturing environment to grow and learn.
- 5. Abandoned children who are found in vulnerable situations and require immediate care and protection.
- 6. Children referred by Child Welfare Committee (CWC) office for protection and care.

At Mathru Abhaya Orphanage, we strive to provide a safe and nurturing environment for children who have faced various forms of adversity in their lives. Our doors are open to children in need, and we are committed to providing them with the love, care, and support they need to grow and thrive



SCHOOLS & COLLEGES

At Mathru Abhaya Orphanage, we currently have a total of 66 students, consisting of 36 girls and 30 boys. These students are enrolled in various private schools and colleges in and around Medipally and Uppal in Hyderabad.

- B. For high school, our students attend Krishnaveni Talent School and Vijaya Ratna High School.
- C. For intermediate, polytechnic, and ITI courses, our students attend JNJP Ramanthapur and Sri Veda Junior College.
- D. For undergraduate courses, our students are enrolled at Arora Engineering College, Pallavi Engineering College, VBIT Engineering College, and Kakatiya University.
- E. For Medical Lab Technician courses, our students are enrolled at TSRTC Vocational Junior College

HEALTH CARE FOR ORPHAN CHILDREN



- At Mathru Abhaya Orphanage, we take the health of our children very seriously. We provide regular medical checkups and timely medical intervention for any health issues. In addition to medical checkups, we also provide nutritious meals, clean drinking water, and maintain proper hygiene to prevent the spread of diseases. We also educate our children about personal hygiene and healthy habits to ensure that they stay healthy and fit.
- However, providing quality healthcare can be expensive, and we rely on the support of donors to continue providing the necessary care for our children. If you wish to support our healthcare initiatives, please visit our website or contact our founder for more information.



At Mathru Abhaya Foundation, we prioritize the health and well-being of our children. In case of any
ordinary ailments or emergencies, we admit the children to nearby hospitals where the consultation
fees are nominal. We also ensure that the prescribed medicines are bought from nearby medical
shops. Additionally, we always maintain a first-aid kit for emergency situations, which includes
necessary medicines and medical supplies. Our goal is to provide the necessary medical care to our
children and ensure their health and safety at all times.

PROVIDE 24 x 7 ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE

Mathru Abhaya Foundation conducts medical camps for the children in their care two to three times per quarter to ensure that all children are healthy and fit. These medical camps provide an opportunity for the children to receive check-ups and necessary medical treatments.






SHELTER FOR ORPHAN CHILDREN



- Mathru Abhaya Foundation provides separate rented homes for boys and girls. These homes are wellequipped with different rooms such as 2 bed rooms, study room, sick room, counselling room, and playing area. The provision of iron racks for keeping clothes and shelves for books, school bags, and other necessary items is a thoughtful addition. The study room with study chairs for all the children to study and complete their homework is also very helpful for their academic progress.
- The playing area at Mathru Abhaya Foundation was generally used for tuition classes as well as a dining hall. Additionally, a water purifier was installed on the premises to provide clean drinking water for the children.
- The rented girls house used by the Mathru Abhaya Foundation had a monthly rent of approximately 40 thousand rupees.
- The rented boys house used by the Mathru Abhaya Foundation had a monthly rent of approximately 30 thousand rupees.
